




Mechelen, Belgium

Gouden Carolus Christmas

Keeping with the Belgian brewing tradition of high-octane holiday season releases, in 2002 Het Anker returned to brewing its iconic Christmas beer, Gouden Carolus Christmas. It's a strong, dark ruby red beer with notes of black licorice and an alcohol percentage of 10.5% ABV – making it among the strongest the brewery produces. Brewed in August, the beer rests a few months to reach an optimal balance. Three kinds of hops and six different kinds of spices define the rich taste of this Christmas beer that beer fans around the world are happy to have back.
